Block 1: August 17 – October 17, 2021

Students can choose to meet online via Zoom or attend in person at SIMS

students will complete 2 weeks of observation between Blocks 1 & 2

Required In-Person Session in Phoenix:

November 8 – 13, 2021

Block 2: November 15 – December 17, 2021

Students can choose to meet online via Zoom or attend in person at SIMS

Block 3: January 11 – March 3, 2022

Students can choose to meet online via Zoom or attend in person at SIMS

Required In-Person Session in Phoenix:

Students will come for 1 week and choose to come either:

Option 1: March 14 – 18, 2022

Option 2: March 21 – 25, 2022

students will complete 4 weeks of practice teaching between Blocks 3 & 4 (this can be broken into 2-week segments)

Block 4: May 2 – 13, 2022

Students can choose to meet online via Zoom or attend in person at SIMS

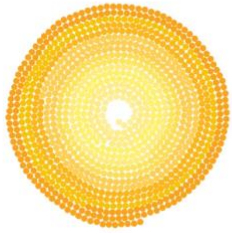
Students will take written exams at the end of this block
